

# "God had better for me": Single mom becomes newest Edisto Habitat for Humanity homeowner Reprinted from the T&D, By Jordone Massey, T&D Correspondent, May 17, 2018

For years, Shara Smith of Bowman has wanted a home of her own for her and her 5-year-old daughter, Taylor.

After her mother moved away to another state, Smith was forced to find adequate housing. Since that transition, Smith has moved to different mobile homes with family members to try to find stable living arrangements for her and her family.

"I used to always apply for apartments or section 8, and it never worked out, and now I see why" Smith said. "Because God had better for me. It was meant for me to get my own house, and I'm so proud of myself. I did it for my daughter, too. I want her to have her own room ...," Smith said.

More than 60 volunteers, most of them women, spent Saturday, May 5, building a home for Smith -- the latest Edisto Habitat for Humanity house in Orangeburg.

Construction of the new house began with a commemoration of

Habitat for Humanity National Women Build Week. The observance encourages more women volunteers to be part of the non-profit Christian organization's work to eliminate poverty housing. HFH volunteers and builders throughout the nation wear blue to celebrate Women Build Week.

Smith's home marks the 81st house that Edisto HFH has built in the Orangeburg County area since its founding in 1991. Edisto was one of the nearly 1,500 Habitat for Humanity affiliates selected to receive the \$5,000 donation from Lowe's that helped make the day possible.

"Lowe's is about giving back to the community," Lowe's of Orangeburg Assistant Store Manager Kiesha Moore said. "We love being in the community, helping the community. We love making people love where they live. When we can get out of the store and volunteer our services, we are more than willing to do so because we are the community.





Smith's home is the second EHFH home that has been built this year, and the organization plans to build two more before the year is over.

Smith's daughter, Taylor, said she was "happy" to be living in her first home because she will finally have a yard of her own to play in. The idea of playing "doll house" with dolls in her own new home excited her. too.

#### From the Executive Director

We Are Building on Faith,

We are planning an Apostles' Build in Orangeburg. Our last one was in 2014, and it was a great success! In an Apostle's Build, 12 churches come together to build one Habitat for Humanity house. They raise the money, and provide the labor and prayer support to build a house in partnership with a local family. As Jesus' original apostles were charged with spreading the word about Jesus, our twelve apostle churches will be charged with assisting in Habitat's mission to provide decent and affordable shelter for God's children in need.

Edisto Habitat for Humanity has built over 80 decent, affordable homes for low-income families in Orangeburg since 1991. We partner with families that have a need for housing, the ability to pay monthly zero interest mortgage payments, and who are willing to give 350 hours of sweat equity time by working on other families' homes, their own home, and by attending homeowner and budgeting classes. The cost of a Habitat home in Orangeburg is approximately \$80,000.00.

We will begin construction on the Apostle Build home in August and complete it by mid-October. We will provide the building site, house plan, and a carefully screened partner family to work beside you to build the home. There will be five Saturdays for volunteers to participate in the construction of the home. We will coordinate all aspects of the build.

The fundraising goal for each Apostle/Church is \$5,000.00. We know some will raise more than \$5,000, and some will raise less. Final payment for this fundraising campaign would not be due to us until the end of October, which would give each Apostle approximately 5 months to raise the funds. We are simply asking churches to set a fundraising goal of \$5,000, and we know God will take care of the details.

We currently have several churches that have committed to be a part of this project and raise these funds outside of their regularly budgeted giving to our affiliate. Will your church be one of the twelve? Will they make a financial commitment? Will they donate their time to the build? We certainly hope so!

Please pass this letter along to your Evangelism/Missions team, and ask your church family to prayerfully consider becoming a part of this exciting project.

We sincerely hope your congregation will step out in faith and commit to be a part of this exciting opportunity. Please do not hesitate to contact me if you would like to discuss any aspect of this opportunity to step out in faith.
